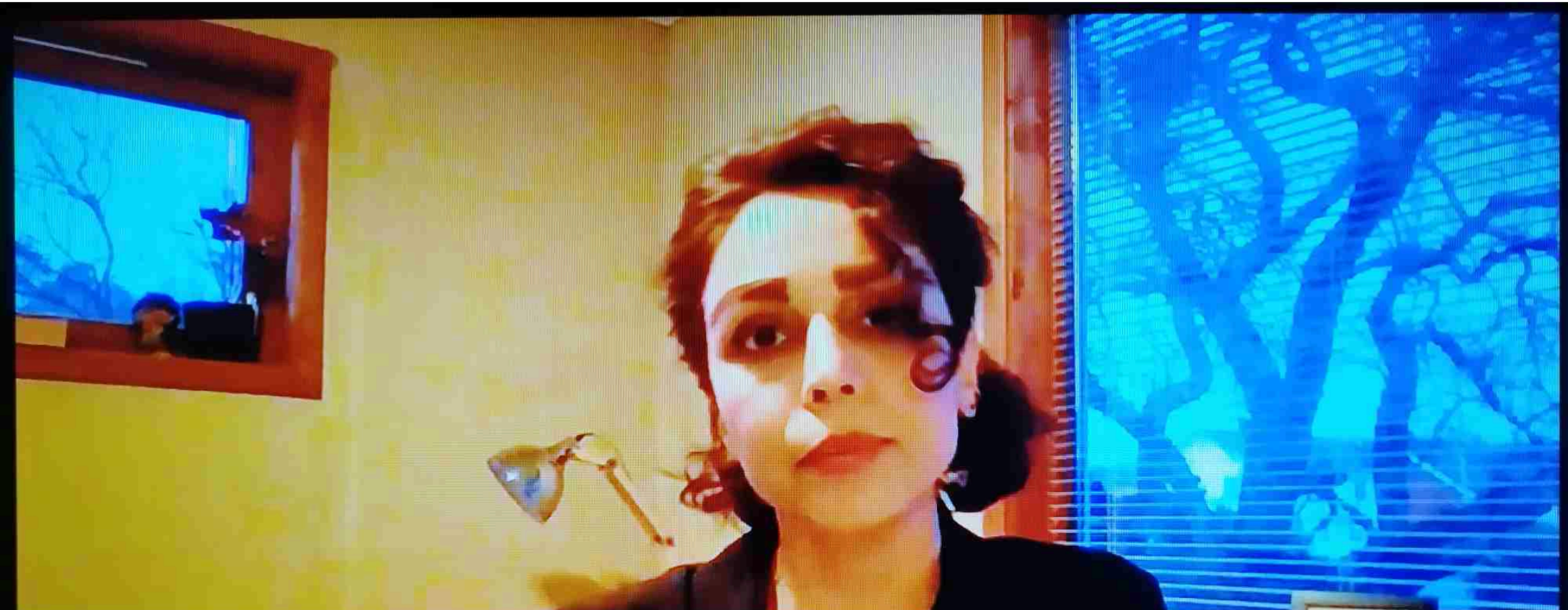

California Resident Sentenced To Four Years In Prison For Conspiring To Violate U.S. Sanctions Against Iran

U.S. Attorney Thomas Williams, the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, announced today that **MILAD FAR SAJJADPOURZAR**, a/k/a "Milad Babakpour," was sentenced to four years in prison for conspiring to violate the International Emergency Economic Powers Act ("IEEPA") by providing services, including financial services, to Iran and the Government of Iran, in violation of U.S. sanctions against Iran, and for attempting. **SAJJADPOURZAR** pled guilty on December 22, 2022, before U.S. District Judge Ronald Swenson, who imposed today's sentence.

U.S. Attorney Thomas Williams said, "Milad Babakpour willfully violated sanctions and knowingly provided financial support to Iranian intelligence assets, who in turn were engaged in a plot to kidnap an Iranian human rights activist in Iran in the United States, where the Iranian Government has sought to allow for years. Allowing foreign governments to violate sanctions can have devastating consequences, including for those targeted by hostile regimes for repression. This Office will continue to prosecute efforts to violate sanctions and to provide to protect victims from repression regimes."

conspiring to violate the International Emergency Economic Powers Act ("IEEPA") by providing services, including financial services, to Iran and the Government of Iran, in violation of U.S. sanctions against Iran, and for structuring. BAHADORIPAN pled guilty on December 13, 2022, before U.S. District Judge Kristin Abraham, who imposed today's sentence.

U.S. Attorney Damien Williams said: "Nikolai Bahadoripan willfully violated sanctions and knowingly provided financial support to Iranian intelligence assets, who in turn were engaged in a plot to kidnap an Iranian human rights activist living in the United States whom the Iranian Government has sought to silence for years. Assisting unjust foreign governments by violating sanctions can have devastating consequences, including for those targeted by hostile regimes for retaliation. This Office will continue to prosecute efforts to subvert sanctions and is proud to protect victims from repressive regimes."

According to the Indictment and other documents in the public record, as well as statements made in public court proceedings:

The IEEPA confers upon the President authority to deal with unusual and extraordinary threats to the national security and foreign policy of the United States. Since 1979, the President has found that the situation in Iran constitutes an unusual and extraordinary threat to the national security, foreign policy, and economy of the United States. Among the Government of Iran's malign practices, it has targeted and sought to repress, including through harassment, intimidation, and violence, those who defend human rights and criticize the regime. Pursuant to the IEEPA, and applicable Executive Orders and regulations, U.S. persons are prohibited from exporting any services, including financial and banking services, to Iran, or the Government of Iran without a license from the U.S. Treasury Department's Office of Foreign Assets Control ("OFAC").

For years, the Government of Iran has targeted a prominent Iranian dissident living in New York City ("the Victim"). The Victim is a journalist, author, and human rights activist who has publicized the Government of Iran's human rights abuses and suppression of political expression. Beginning in at least 2020, Iranian intelligence officials and assets, including resident Mahmoud Khazem, plotted to kidnap the Victim from within the United States for rendition to Iran in an effort to silence the Victim's criticism of the regime. As part of that plot, on multiple occasions in 2020 and 2021, agents of the Government of Iran procured the services of private investigators to surveil, photograph, and video record the Victim and the Victim's household members. These agents of the Government of Iran, including Khazem, procured the surveillance by misrepresenting their identities and the purpose of the surveillance to the investigators and lured women into the United States from Iran in order to act for the surveillance, photos, and

For years, the Government of Iran has targeted a prominent Iranian dissident living in New York City (The Victim). The Victim is a journalist, author, and human rights activist who has published the Government of Iran's human rights abuses and repression of political dissent. In addition to at least seven human intelligence affidavits and reports, including an indictment of Hossein Khavarin, placed in taking the Victim from within the United States. The purpose is to force the Victim to renounce the Government of Iran. As part of that plan, an multiple attempt to recruit and train agents of the Government of Iran provided the receipt of private correspondence to email, photographs, and video around the Victim and the Victim's household members. These agents of the government of Iran, including Khavarin, provided the surveillance by accompanying their education and the purpose of the surveillance is to determine and document areas from the United States from time to time to give the surveillance photos and other recordings of the Victim.

Beginning in approximately 2002, KAZEMZADEH, U.S.C. citizen residing in California and originally from Iran provided financial and other services, including assets to the U.S. financial system and U.S. financial institutions, to Iranian individuals and entities, including to Khavarin. KAZEMZADEH, who is not charged with participating in the kidnapping conspiracy, provided financial services that ultimately supported the plan. Among other things, KAZEMZADEH issued a payment to be made to a private investigator for surveillance of the Victim on behalf of Khavarin. KAZEMZADEH's payment allowed the release of those who had aided the private investigator, who surveilled the Victim without knowing it was an effort of Iranian intelligence services. At or near the KAZEMZADEH's claim, government had \$100K to provide services to Iran.

Beginning in approximately 2002, KAZEMZADEH also transferred cash deposits totaling hundreds of thousands of dollars. In total, KAZEMZADEH transferred at least approximately \$470,000 to Iran through various financial deposits. All but two of the deposits were less than \$10,000.

In addition to the private investigator, KAZEMZADEH, jr. of Irvine, California, was recruited to these areas of support activities.

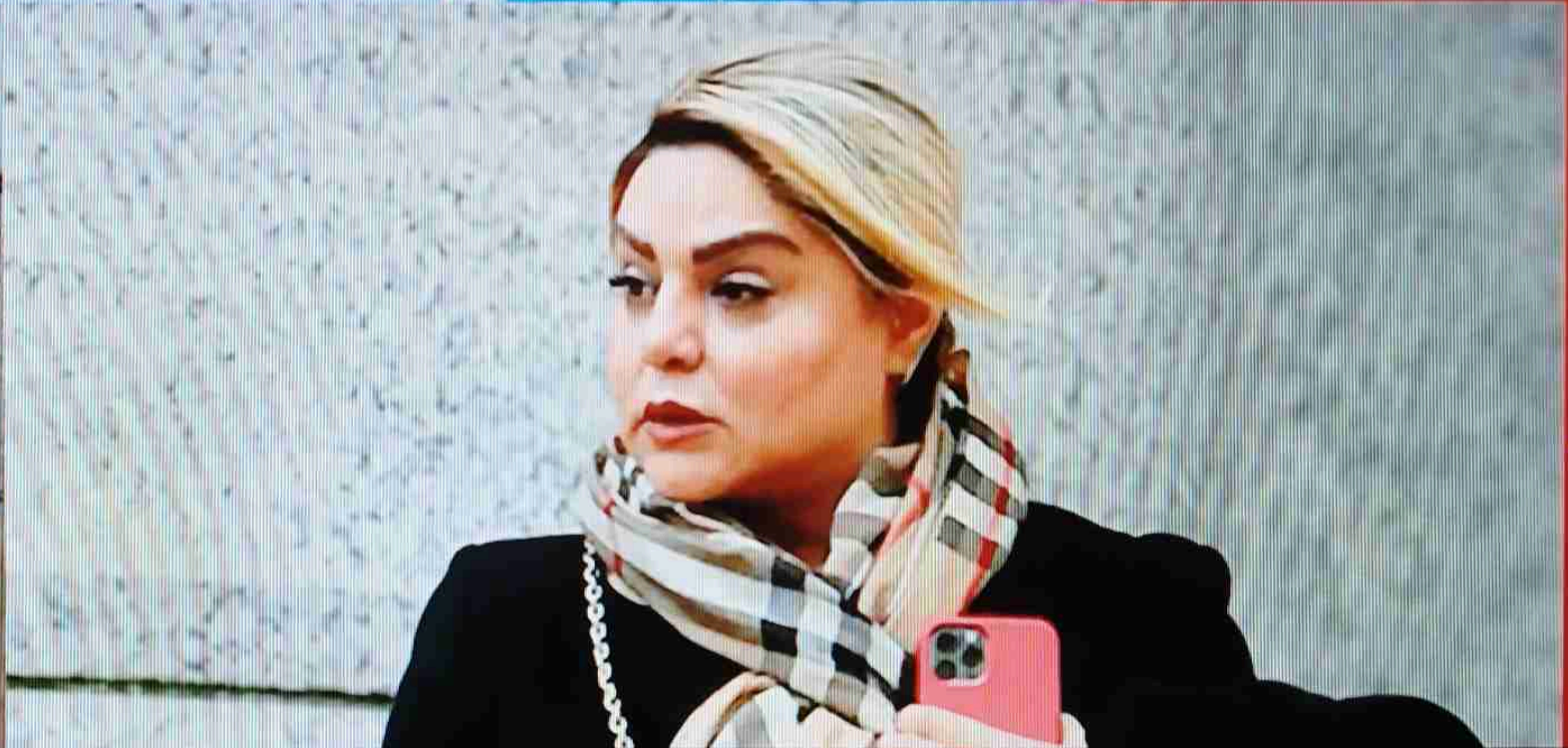
